Genesis 3:21 NLT And the LORD God made clothing from animal skins for Adam and his wife.

In a Shockingly Awesome Act – As Bloody as it Was – Mercy was Put on Display, Given as an Undeserving Gift.

The First Death Ever - Was a Sacrifice, Not of Worship, But for Rescuing. And it was by God Himself - for Mankind.

God had taken the life of an Innocent Animal in Genesis 3 to become the covering for Adam & Eve's Naked Sin.

The Animal Skin Couldn't Take Away Sin but Only Cover It. A Greater Act of Mercy Would Be Needed in Time.

Mercies grk: oiktirmos to have in your possession, to feel, to experience, to have compassion for or pity upon.

Romans 5:8-9

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Whenever Mercy is Extended,

It must always come - at the expense of the One showing mercy.

"The Origin / Foundation of Our Worship Is founded upon One Central Doctrine = Worship. Worship which is the act of Offering. Worship must first begin with an offering of blood that is willing presented.

It was expensive. It was terrible & It was bloody."

Leviticus 17:11

For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you upon the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

Hebrews 9:22c ESV

Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sins.

How Can We Love God With All of Our Faith?

Warning: Do Not Try This At Home (This Is What NOT To Do)

Genesis 4:1-7

Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, and said, "I have acquired a man from the LORD." **2** Then she bore again, this time his brother Abel. Now Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. **3** And in the process of time it came to pass that Cain brought an offering of the fruit of the ground to the LORD. **4** Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat. And the LORD respected Abel and his offering, **5** but He did not respect Cain and his offering. And Cain was very angry, and his countenance fell. **6** So the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? **7** If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire *is* for you, but you should rule over it."

So How Can We Love God With All of Our Faith?

1 John 5:4-5 NIV

For everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. 5 Who is it that overcomes the world? Only the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

The YOU here makes this a personal act of Worship.

Pre'sent

The Greek word for present has this meaning – that with premeditation - - you offer that or who which is being pre-sented as being dedicated, offered, given to God.

Here is Jesus' teaching on this truth;

Mark 8:35 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake and the Gospel's will save it. (Matthew, Mark, Luke)

Luke 9:23-24 Then Jesus said to them all, "If anyone (1) desires to come after Me, let him (2) deny himself, and (3) take up his cross daily, and (4) follow Me. For whoever desires to SAVE his life will LOSE it, but whoever <mark>(5) loses his life</mark> for My sake <mark>will save it</mark>. What is it to "Desire to Come After Jesus"? Have you come after Jesus Christ in your own life? What is it to "Deny Yourself"? Have you ever told you 'no you cannot have that or this'? What is it to "Carry Your Cross"? Have you been carrying your own cross – change crosses now? What is it to "Follow Him"? Have you been following Him like a target? What is it to "Lose Your Life"? Have you discovered just how unimportant you are? SO GIVE GOD YOUR BODY ONE LIFE TO LIVE FOR NOW 2b.) In an act of willful hope vs. 1b Verse 1b

holy, acceptable to God.

- Holy grk: hagios Set away from and apart from for a cause or mission, religious awe, sacred, sainted, a sanctuary for God.
- Acceptable grk: euarestos well-pleasing, a glad and happy position, place, relationship.

This Defines The Christians True Freedom No longer Unholy. <mark>No longer</mark> Unacceptable

Galatians 4:7 Therefore you are no longer a **slave** but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ.

> Romans 7:14 For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin.

This HOPE stands in stark contrast to slave market

of the ancient Greco-Roman world.

How important is human trafficking to you?

Joseph was Sold into the slave Market of Egypt

Genesis 37:28

Then Midianite traders passed by; so the brothers pulled Joseph up and lifted him out of the pit, and sold him to the Ishmaelites for twenty shekels of silver. And they took Joseph down to Egypt.

Unlike us - Joseph (being innocent) was Swept Away into Captivity

- Enslaved to Your Fear
- Enslaved to Your Money
- Enslaved to Your Pot
- Enslaved to Your Drugs
- Enslaved to Your Sex
- Enslaved to Your Power
- Enslaved to Your Porn
- Enslaved to Your World

Matthew 24:36-39,48-51

"But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only. 37 But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. 38 For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, 39 and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be... - 48 But if that evil servant says in his heart, "My master is delaying his coming,' 49 and begins to beat his fellow servants, and to eat and drink with the drunkards, 50 the master of that servant will come on a day when he is not looking for him and at an hour that he is not aware of, 51 and will cut him in two and appoint him his portion with the hypocrites.

There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. (Hell)

So Again - How important is human trafficking to you?

In the 1st. Century Roman Empire - there were an almost infinite number of reasons why you might have been found on the slave-market in Rome.

Debt / Servitude / Labor / Sex Objects / Human Harvesting / Trading. { The buyer would **"walk-the-line"** to see who was worth buying }

But Then Along Came Jesus Christ -

He Walked into The Slave-Market of this World and there you were. Dirty, Cut, Bruised, Scared, Broken, Used, Done... (And I'm just talking about you - on the outside)

"Sold to the highest Bidder - Jesus!

Who gave Your own Blood to Purchase these Lost Wretches.

We need to look <mark>longer</mark> at the people in our lives. We need to look <mark>closer</mark> at them.

We need to see them on the inside - where it really matters

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 NLT

Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself, 20 for God bought you with a high price. So you must honor God with your body.

service/worship

grk: latreia / proskynéō

that which is divine worship, service or better - to be in the service of worship. also translated proskynéō = prós, meaning to move towards" and ky'neo, to kiss the ground or to fall down before a sovereign. The act of presenting ones face or forehead to the hand of the king. to bow and to kiss the hand. (the same word is used for a dog to lick the hand of his owner or master. proskynéō suggests the willingness to make all necessary physical gestures of obeisance.

- 2. Merciful or kindly.

"a propitious deity."

3. Convenient; auspicious; favorable; kind.
