The Revelation of Jesus Christ as King of Israel and Savior of the World

SUBJECT TOPICALLY REFERENCED UNDER:

Passion Week, Palm Sunday, Dedication, Devotion, Sacrifice, The Will of God.

Luke 19:29-48

And it came to pass, when He drew near to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mountain called Olivet, that He sent two of His disciples, 30 saying, "Go into the village opposite you, where as you enter you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Loose it and bring it here. 31 And if anyone asks you, "Why are you loosing it?' thus you shall say to him, 'Because the Lord has need of it.' " 32 So those who were sent went their way and found it just as He had said to them. 33 But as they were loosing the colt, the owners of it said to them, "Why are you loosing the colt?" 34 And they said, "The Lord has need of him." 35 Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. 36 And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road. 37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, 38 saying: " 'Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples." 40 But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out." 41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, 42 saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. 43 For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, 44 and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation." 45 Then He went into the temple and began to drive out those who bought and sold in it, 46 saying to them, "It is written, "My house is a house of prayer," but you have made it a 'den of thieves.' " 47 And He was teaching daily in the temple. But the chief priests, the scribes, and the leaders of the people sought to destroy Him, 48 and were unable to do anything; for all the people were very attentive to hear Him.

JESUS IS THE KING

1.) The Coming of The King

1a.) Was the promise of the scriptures

Genesis 3:15

And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."

Ephesians 1:4-5,9-10a

Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, **5** having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will. **9** Having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, **10** that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ,

Matthew 21:4-5

All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: **5** "Tell the daughter of Zion, 'Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.'"

Zechariah 9:9

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He is just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

John 12:15-16 NLT

15 "Don't be afraid, people of Jerusalem. Look, your King is coming, riding on a donkey's colt." 16 His disciples didn't understand at the time that this was the fulfillment of prophecy. But after Jesus entered into His glory, they remembered what had happened and realized that these things had been written about Him.

1b.) Was the prerogative of God

Luke 19:35-38

Then they brought him to Jesus. And they threw their own clothes on the colt, and they set Jesus on him. 36 And as He went, many spread their clothes on the road. 37 Then, as He was now drawing near the descent of the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works they had seen, 38 saying: "'Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the LORD!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

2a.) A cry of hope

A Week Filled With Reality & A Divided Crowd of Witnesses.

John 12:12-13

The next day a great multitude that had come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, **13** took branches of palm trees and went out to meet Him, and cried out: "Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' The King of Israel!"

Israel was Under The Occupation of the Roman Empire. And the "400 Years of Silence" was About to End.

A Revival of His Word Among His People Always Gives Light.

Hope Springs Forth

All Treatments Might Fail – But Hope in Jesus Christ is Forever.

Luke 19:39-40

And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples." **40** But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

The Messianic Psalms 118:5-6

Luke 19:37-38

Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

Oh, what joy for those whose disobedience is forgiven, whose sin is put out of sight!

2c.) A cry of salvation

Matthew 21:9

Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: "Hosanna (SAVE NOW, SAME NOW) to the Son of David! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!' Hosanna in the highest!"

But Why Did They Do This?

Psalms 118:25-26a

(Hosanna) Save now, I pray, O LORD; O LORD, I pray, send now prosperity. **26** Blessed is he who comes in the name of the LORD!

1 Peter 1:10-12

Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you, **11** searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. **12** To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into.

JESUS IS KING

3.) The <mark>Call</mark> of God

3a.) Is to the nation (Israel)

The Nation of Israel is The Epicenter of God's Promises.

Micah 7:19-20

He will again have compassion on us (ISRAEL), and will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins (ISRAEL), into the depths of the sea. **20** You will give truth to Jacob and mercy to Abraham, which You have sworn to our fathers (ISRAEL), From days of old.

Jeremiah 31:35-37 NLT

It is the LORD who provides the sun to light the day and the moon and stars to light the night, and who stirs the sea into roaring waves. His name is the LORD of Heaven's Armies, and this is what he says: 36 "I am as likely to reject my people Israel as I am to abolish the laws of nature!" 37 This is what the LORD says: "Just as the heavens cannot be measured and the foundations of the earth cannot be explored, so I will not consider casting them away for the evil they have done. I, the LORD, have spoken!

Zechariah 2:12-13

And the LORD will take possession of Judah as His inheritance in the Holy Land, and will again choose Jerusalem. **13** Be silent, all flesh, before the LORD, for He is aroused from His holy habitation!"

THE CALL OF GOD JESUS IS THE KING

3b.) Is to all people (the world)

Psalm 145:18

The LORD is near to ALL who call upon Him, TO ALL who call upon Him in truth.

Zechariah 2:11

"Many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and they shall become My people. And I will dwell in your midst. Then you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you.

Psalm 18:6

In my distress I called upon the LORD, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, *even* to His ears.

THE CALL OF GOD

JESUS IS THE KING

3c.) Is to you (directly)

Make a Vivid Connection.

Verse 41-44

41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, 42 saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. 43 For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, 44 and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another,

because you did not know the time of your visitation."

Romans 10:12-13

For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. **13** For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

Who was in that crowd on this Sunday 1,993 years ago? What were they feeling and who was feeling what?

* Were there people sick & ill there? * Were there People wounded there?

* Were there People hurting there? * Were there people empty there?

* Were there people confused there? * Were there people in need there? * Were there people lost there?

Matthew 9:36

But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, **like sheep having no** shepherd.

Wherever you're at. Whatever you're doing. The God of the Bible, the One and Only true God – knows all things and sees you.

God is watching.

Because He cannot keep his eyes off of you -- But not to punish you or to destroy you, but to finally break through the crowd so that you might invite HIM into your life - to deliver you and heal you and save you.
