vs. 4

## Hebrews 13:4

4 Marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled;  
but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

## The Sacred Institution of Marriage as Designed by God

*Body* by Yahweh

**Honorable** grk: timios  
infinite in value, precious, respected, sacred,  
of great cost and expense.

## Priority One

“Let All People Give Honor and Reverence to Marriage”

## Genesis 2:18

And the LORD God said, *“It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him.”*

## Genesis 2:23-24

And Adam said: *“This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man.”* **24** Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined (union or united to) to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

## Matthew 19:6

So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, let not man separate.”

**Bed** koite;  
as in sexual intimacy, the union of a man and a woman, the bed, the place of sanctity, joy and blessing.

Undefined amiantos:

undefined, clean, untainted, clear, free as in free and clear, protected from all injury (illness) and free from anything that seeks to harm, degrade.

**1 Corinthians 7:1-5c NLT**

**Now regarding the questions you asked in your letter. Yes, it is good to abstain from sexual relations. 2 But because there is so much sexual immorality, each man should have his own wife, and each woman should have her own husband. 3 The husband should fulfill his wife's sexual needs, and the wife should fulfill her husband's needs. 4 The wife gives authority over her body to her husband, and the husband gives authority over his body to his wife. 5 Do not deprive each other of sexual relations, unless you both agree to refrain from sexual intimacy for a limited time so you can give yourselves more completely to prayer. Afterward, you should come together again so that Satan won't be able to tempt you**
