Romans 14:13-23

Therefore, let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way. 14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean. 15 Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died. 16 Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil; 17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit. 18 For he who serves Christ in these things is acceptable to God and approved by men. 19 Therefore let us pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another. 20 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All things indeed are pure, but it is evil for the man who eats with offense.

21 It is good neither to eat meat nor drink wine nor do anything by which your brother stumbles or is offended or is made weak. **22** Do you have faith? Have it to yourself before God. Happy is he who does not condemn himself in what he approves.

23 But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.

A Hybrid Introduction to the Text

Verses 13 to 16 being the summation of what has already been studied – serves as a bridge to what the Apostle Paul is about to lead us into.

Using Verse 13 – Paul Connects Verse 1-12 with this Preamble to His Argument;

Romans 14:13

Therefore, let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way.

The Great "Therefores" of the Bible;

Like a Linguistically Glue, A Theological Bond that Welds Us to What has Been Previously Stated.

Resolve grk: mallon

all the more. to go beyond, to be extravagant with this.

Stumbling grk: proskomma

to set up or to create a trip hazard, to make an occasion of stumbling,

to put an obstacle on a path.

Fall grk: skandalon

to bait a trap, to pressure or to coerce someone into doing what they believe to be

wrong. ("I knew I should not have done that")

The conclusion is this...

Watch out where you step, Make sure your foot is following in His steps. Putting your foot down where His was.

1a.) Is Having A Clean Conscience

vs. 14

Romans 14:14

14 I know and am convinced by the Lord Jesus that there is nothing unclean of itself; but to him who considers anything to be unclean, to him it is unclean

Convinced grk: peitho;

confident, certain, made aware of, have come to know, fully persuaded.

1 Timothy 4:1-4

Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons, **2** speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron, **3** forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from foods which God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth. **4** For every creature of God is good, and nothing is to be refused if it is received with thanksgiving; **5** for it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer.

Having a clean or cleared conscience before God and man

"A clear conscience is often understood as that inner sense of right and wrong, aligning one's behavior and intentions with moral and divine standards. There is a consistent thread throughout Scripture that shows conscience is a God-given faculty. This observable reality of man's struggle with what is right and wrong is one of the most powerful evidences of man having been created by the ultimate morality which is God Himself."

Romans 2:14-15

For when Gentiles (a non-Jews), who do not have the law, by nature do the things in the law, these, although not having the law, are a law to themselves, **15** who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them)

1b.) Is Having The Right Priority

vs. 15

Verse 15

15 Yet if your brother is grieved because of your food, you are no longer walking in love. Do not destroy with your food the one for whom Christ died.

Remembering that: The first century Christians were Jews. Later,

those Born Again, Jews preached Jesus Christ from Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and out to the other most parts of the earth. With their success at evangelism, more and more Gentiles in great numbers began populating the church.

If we fix our eyes and affection upon Jesus, we will quickly see Him elevated to His rightful place of honor in the church.

Acts 2:1-14a

When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.

3 Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

In Hot Pursuit Of the Kingdom of God

2a.) Is All About Our Familial Witness

vs. 16

Romans 14:16

16 Therefore do not let your good be spoken of as evil

UNDERSTANDING THIS; THIS IS NOT AS EASY AS IT LOOKS

Matthew 10:36

A man's enemies will be those of his own household.

Step #1:

Make sure you're firmly grounded upon the Word of God.

1 Corinthians 10:29-30 NLT

It might not be a matter of conscience for you, but it is for the other person. For why should my freedom be limited by what someone else thinks? 30 If I can thank God for the food (or anything amoral) and enjoy it, why should I be condemned for eating it?

Yet, we are not free to give people a reason to reject faith in Jesus Christ Just because you have the freedom (liberty) to live out your faith (convictions)

"To the beach or not to the beach – It's not question (for Lisa & I)"

2 Corinthians 6:3-10

We give no offense in anything, that our ministry may not be blamed. **4** But in all *things* we commend ourselves as ministers of God: in much patience, in tribulations, in needs, in distresses, **5** in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in sleeplessness, in fastings; **6** by purity, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Spirit, by sincere love, **7** by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, **8** by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report; as deceivers, and *yet* true; **9** as unknown, and *yet* well known; as dying, and behold we live; as chastened, and *yet* not killed; **10** as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and *yet* possessing all things.

Step #2:

Make sure you Understand that just the Name of Jesus Christ Himself will cause "Evil to be spoken of." The reality of, the person of Jesus Christ generates hatred (which is always a manifestation of a spiritually irrational person)

2b.) Is All About Real Christ-Like Living

vs. 17

Romans 14:17

17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 8:8

But food does not commend us to God; for neither if we eat are we the better, nor if we do not eat are we the worse.

Hebrews 13:9

Do not be carried about with various and strange doctrines. For *it is* good that the heart be established by grace, not with foods which have not profited those who have been occupied with them.

The Forever Kingdom of God

2 Samuel 7:16

"Your house (David) and your kingdom shall be established forever before you.

Your throne shall be established forever."

Psalms 45:6

Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom.

Exodus 15:18

"The LORD shall reign forever and ever."

Peace grk: eirene

No longer at war with God thus now having the rest of God upon you.

Joy grk: chara

joy is a non-human attribute or characteristic; joy is of an external source

and must be provided.

These Three (3) are One, A United Trinity of Evidence, of Proof That the Real Christian has These in his or her possession.

1 John 5:7 KJV

For there are three (3) that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit: and these three are one.
