Appeal

grk: para'kale'o

conciliate, to act or overreact to make a point = to urge with much action, to entreat with great zeal and passion – to pacify or to make pacific by winning over. to labor to make calm.

Like a Referee;
in a boxing ring who violently breaks up the fight

Exhortation: **grk: Para'kles'is**
to call out to or the calling so as to come alongside to aid another, to encourage others by comforting them, consoling them, provoking them to be encouraged.

Like Someone;
encouraging you by slapping you in the face to get your attention.

Verse 24-25

24 Greet all those who rule over you, and all the saints.
Those from Italy greet you. **25** Grace be with you all. Amen.
